The City has hired topic expert professionals to lead us through a public process and a plan update.

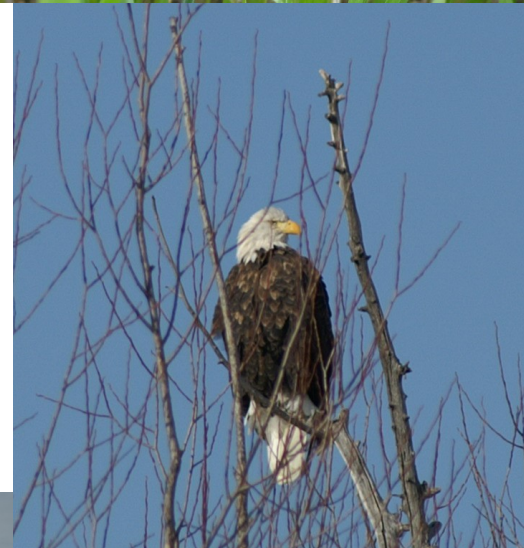
